Dear Mother i embrace the present oportunity of riting a few lines to you to inform you that wee are all well at this time hoping that thes few lines may fined you enjoying like blessings i received a letter from John and Sally Miller a few days ago i was verry glad to hear that you was all well this is quite a wet morning and almost the first thing i saw after i got out of bed was Thomas Loper and Mr Wm George coming Down the hill they said they was so tired that they had to stay in Salem last night they went as far Down the river as viksburg but could get no employment there Mother i want you and brother George and Margaret to arrange your bussness so as to come here if it is your wish it is my pleasure for you to Do so if you can arrange so as to come without me going Do so if not rite to me and i will come after you george is here he thinks his health is better than it was there tell John Miller that horses is rating from \$50 to \$100 tell him that i am verry sure that mules will sell better than horses or mares mules is rating from 50 to 150 Dollars at this time tell Deborah that it seems to be a Dull chance here for a school i want you to rite and let us know you are all Doing i must close by remaing your affectionate son till Death wee wish to be remembered to all enquireing friends tell Isaac Loper if it is convenient i want him to fetch or send the stove
