Carl Terry Killed When Hit By Electric Wire At Coal Mine

Carl Terry, 20, was almost instantly killed at the mines of Cane Creek Coal Co. at Bankhead Saturday afternoon at about one o'clock, when he came in contact with a live wire. It is reported that the young man, in company with others, were on an electric motor and Carl raised his head while passing under the wire, the current striking him in the back of the neck.

First aid methods were promptly used and continued for some time, but it is believed that death was almost instantaneous.

The funeral was held at Sardis Church near Bankhead Sunday afternoon at 2:30 o'clock, Reverends Manasco and Pettus conducting the services and burial was in Sardis cemetery, Legg in charge.

Carl was a splendid young man and popular with those who knew him. His father was terribly injured in the mines at Good Springs by a falling rock last fall, and died about ten days later at Walker County Hospital.
