BIOGRAPHY: John Thomas Terry Sr. raised 13 children. The oldest was Ada Ruth Terry who married my Grandfather Jack Walker. Joseph Woodson (Joe) was the father of Murrell Terry who had a place near Jack Walker in Pecan Grove. Jerry Mack was Murrell's son and one of my good friends at Pecan Grove where I went to school. John Thomas Terry had a daughter named Mary Armour whom my mother Estelle Armour Walker may be named after. Ada Ruth Terry died in 1900 in childbirth when my Aunt Ruth was born. John Thomas also had a son Reuben Riley who was the father of Warden Terry. Warden was born in January 1918 and married Emily Munsell in Pecan Grove. She was probably a daughter of the Munsells who lived across the river from Grandpa Walker. There was a river crossing called Munsell Crossing where cars could be driven across much of the year. This was also a well known swimming hole we all used as kids. Warden Terry was a prominent attorney, county judge and close friend of the Billy Walker family.
